Education Summit

The Summit will be January 24th, 8:30AM. Location is yet to be determined.

Ms. O'Doherty reported that the DOT met with the 110th and 115th Precinct about safety around schools. She said each school should have a safety plan that includes locations of buses and crossing guards and where parents can drop off and pick up their children. The DOT has a person who will work with schools. She suggested that traffic agents be located around schools during arrival and dismissal. Mr. Sharinn suggested that the Council invite the precincts to attend a meeting and discuss how they can help. Mr. Greenberg suggested reaching out to the Mayor's office. Ms. Alexander said the Council will consider a meeting in March.
