**District Planning Presentation: District 30 Data Summary, District Needs and Priorities, followed by Public Comment**

Reba Lichtenstein, District Planning, shared an overview of District Planning which partners with communities to identify and address needs and priorities through the district planning process. Max Applebaum, Senior Director of Bronx and Queens Planning joined the presentation. Results of the survey for the new middle school in Sunnyside, Q429, were reviewed. The school will open with 6<sup>th</sup> grade and add a grade each year. Discussions regarding truncation of P.S. 150 and P.S. 11 are continuing. The final decision about geographic priority for Q429 will be made by the first day of school. Dr. Composto requested a one-page fact sheet explaining geographic priority to parents. Giving admission priority to specific groups may be considered. Donna Taylor, Office of School Design, will be working with the Council, Superintendent and community when planning the school design.
